Traumas of the past can be lodged and held in the body; there are varying models available to explain how this happens. The models we choose to use affect the way we apply SI when working with clients. We will look at two models; Roger Woolger's Deep Memory Process, a body oriented past and present life regression therapy, and Karlton Terry's Pre and Perinatal Education which examines how our very early experiences are carried as patterns throughout life. We will explore the theory behind these models and how they might be integrated into and shape our views of SI. Participants will be able to experience both of these models
