Course Description: In this 4-day workshop Ed Maupin will share two essential aspects of his work - Touch-Communication and Movement. Quoting Ed Maupin: Touch-Communication “I truly believe that awareness makes the change. I have a teachable system which emphasizes awareness and creates a rich interaction between practitioner and client. The practitioner learns to touch receptively, rather than coerce or force. The client is trained to participate, so that the interaction becomes two-way.” Movement (Expansional Balance) “The body is a "spring-loaded anti-gravity device which is designed to expand in all directions in response to gravity. I have used Expansional Balance as the most coherent and unified movement theory which underlines our work. Every procedure in the Rolf method pursues one of the 'Four Parts of Expansional Balance.' This understanding can organize our sessions and enhance our ability to 'see' structure.”

Instructors Bio: Ed Maupin completed his training with Dr. Rolf in 1968 and hence he is one of the two-longest-practicing practitioners of Rolf Structural Integration in the world today. He teaches in San Diego at his school - the Institute of Psycho-Structural Balancing (IPSB). As a psychologist (Ph.D U.Michigan, 1962) whose degree research was in Zen Buddhist meditation, he places a huge emphasis on the role of awareness in the SI process.
