Course Description: This 4-day workshop will focus on how to bring integration into any intervention, whether we are doing single or multiple sessions in the context of Structural Integration. In service of that, we will spend our class time looking in detail at the relationships around the occipito/atlantal junction, the thoracic outlet, and the lumbo/sacro/iliac junction. We will examine how opening the intervention, and closure, are accomplished for work in these critical regions. Particular attention will be given to developing palpation skills for the articular and soft tissue patterns in the regions we are studying. There will be power point presentations for the anatomy, handouts for the specific techniques, and closely supervised practical exercises. Students will take away deeper understanding of the neck and low back, and how to manage these important regions in the practice of Structural Integration.

Instructor Biography: Jan Sultan was trained by Ida Rolf beginning in 1969. He has practiced full time since then, and is also on the faculty of the Rolf Institute®. He teaches continuing education, basic trainings, and advanced classes.
