**Course Description:** Scar tissue integration is Sharon's original work. It evolved from and is related to Rolwing®, but it is like speaking a different language. There are at least ten different direct manipulation techniques that are used to smooth out scar tissue. They are easy to learn and easy to do. These techniques as well as the principles which generated them will be taught with lots of opportunity for hands on practice. Sharon was certified by Dr. Rolf in 1970 and Judith Aston in Rolf Movement® in 1971. She teaches from an artistic perspective with lots of hands-on individual attention -- and she tells Rolwing® stories, legends and lore.

**Instructors Bio:** Sharon Wheeler-Hancoff Sharon trained in Structural Integration in the two Big Sur River House classes in 1970. She trained in the first Rolf Movement Integration class with Judith Aston in 1971.
