Course Description: Scar tissue integration is Sharon's original work. It evolved from and is related to Rolfing, but it is like speaking a different language. There are at least ten different direct manipulation techniques that are used to smooth out scar tissue. They are easy to learn and easy to do. These techniques as well as the principles which generated them will be taught with lots of opportunity for hands on practice. Sharon was certified by Dr. Rolf in 1970 and Judith Aston in Rolf Movement® in 1971. She teaches from an artistic perspective with lots of hands-on individual attention and she tells Rolfing® stories, legends and lore.

Instructors Bio: Sharon trained in Structural Integration in the two Big Sur River House classes in 1970. She trained in the first Rolf Movement® Integration class with Judith Aston in 1971. In 1973 Sharon did a second practitioner class with Dr. Rolf at the Adam's House in Big Sur and then in 1979 she did the Philadelphia Advanced Training with Dr. Rolf. Sharon is a member of the Guild for Structural Integration, the Rolf Institute of Structural Integration® and the International Association of Structural Integrators®. She maintains a practice in Structural Integration and Rolf Movement® in Port Orchard, WA. She teaches Continuing Education classes for IASI and RISI. Her workshop topics include Scar Tissue, Bones, The Art of Rolfing® and an Extended 7th session.
